OUR POLICY COMMITMENTS

- Manage those business processes that have the potential to impact significantly upon the environment, whether internal activities or the advice we provide to customers, in accordance with the requirements of the international environmental management standard BS EN ISO 14001:2004.
- Assess our use of natural resources, the direct impacts associated with our office and site activities and the indirect impacts associated with our procurement practices.
- Comply with regulatory requirements and identify new areas where we can improve our environmental performance, focusing our efforts on those activities with the most significant impacts.
- Set objectives and targets for improved environmental performance and develop and apply suitable key performance indicators that will allow us to track our progress.
- Provide our staff with training and awareness in support of our policy commitments and vision for the environment.
- Disclose information on how we are progressing with the implementation of our policy in a format that promotes the engagement of external stakeholders.
- Use our knowledge of emerging issues to refine and improve our environmental policy.

RESPONSIBILITIES

Primary accountability for Entec's environmental policy statement rests with the Managing Director. The Managing Director appoints the Environmental Technical Advisor to report to the Managing Director, and to advise the UK Management Team and the Quality Manager on the Environmental Management System. The Quality Manager is responsible for the day to day implementation of the environmental policy. The UK Management Team is responsible for reviewing the policy statement and Entec's progress with its implementation at regular intervals.
